Pam and I, and our consigners, are excited to welcome you to southern Ohio for the 2010 sale. We continue to strive to produce functional Boer goats that excel in the show ring, as well as, in production. Our commitment to performance can be measured by our participation in competitive buck tests in the region. We placed two bucks on the 2009 Kentucky Buck Test and both bucks finished in the top ten. A son of Hollywood Hotshot topped the test sale and is owned in partnership by a prominent wether breeder in Kentucky. The Hotshot buck ultrasounded a loin in excess of three inches. We have two bucks currently competing on the 2010 Kentucky test and placed two bucks on the 2010 Pennsylvania test. Certainly a phenotypically attractive animal is important, but phenotype must be balanced against feed conversion and carcass yield.

Riverview Boer Goats has continued its tradition of quality in quantity through embryo transfer and laparoscopic AI procedures. We have two ennobled bucks in production and have two other bucks that have accumulated all their own ABGA points and are simply waiting for the balance of their kid points and/or kid inspections. We offer you approximately sixty lots from our farm. In an effort to enhance value for our customers, we have chosen to offer over 20 exposed does in this year's sale. Many are already showing signs of pregnancy.

Red Gate Farm, owned by Phillip and Anita Messer, and their son Levi, consigned several lots to the sale. For those of you who follow the show ring, you will recall the dominance their goats display in exhibition. The genetic packages they offer in this sale are from some of the same lines that have produced seven National Champions.
